ORDER OF FINAL SETTLEMENT.

Now on this 16th day of February, 1959, at 2.00 o'clock P.M. comes on for hearing the petition of R. H. Kilgore, guardian, for the termination of the above described guardianship. The guardian appearing in person and by his attorney George S. Benson.

The court upon examining the files and hearing statements of the guardian finds that notice of this hearing has been given in conformity with law and the order of this court and that Petition for Termination of Guardianship filed herein on the 30th day of January, 1959, may be heard at this time.

Thereupon evidence was offered in support of the Petition for Termination of the Guardianship and the guardian was examined relative to the petition and the final account attached thereto.

The Court upon considering said evidence finds that the statements contained in said Petition are true and correct. That John S. Adsit, an insane person, died on or about the _____ day of January, 1959, and by reason thereof the guardianship in the above entitled matter should be terminated. That the final account of the guardian which was filed in this matter on January 13, 1959, in connection with the resignation of the guardian, together with all annual accounts theretofore filed by the guardian in this matter are true, accurate and correct and that the guardian has faithfully discharged all of the duties of his trust.

The court further finds that since the filing of the final account the guardian has had the following expenses: Probate Court Butler County, Kansas, for costs \$12.35 and to George S. Benson, as attorney for guardian in his resignation and upon termination of the guardianship \$50.00. That the guardian is entitled to a fee of \$400.00 for his past services as such fiduciary. That said costs and expenses



are just and reasonable charges against the estate and the guardian is hereby authorized and directed to pay the same from funds in his hands as such guardian. That upon payment of the above sums there will remain in the possession of the guardian the sum of \$175.27 which amount the guardian is hereby authorized and directed to pay to The Dunsford Funeral Home of Augusta, Kansas, to apply on the funeral expenses of said John S. Adsit. That upon payment of the above sums no personal property remains.

That upon payment of the funds in the manner above described and upon filing receipts for same with this court the said guardian and his bondsmen shall be released from further liability.

NOW THEREFORE it is considered, ordered and adjudged that John S. Adsit died on or about the _____ day of January, 1959, and the above entitled guardianship be and the same is hereby terminated.



Adsit of Butler County, Kansas, was duly and legally adjudged to be an insane person in a hearing then had in the Probate Court of Butler County, Kansas; and whereas in said action it was there determined that the said John S. Adsit was possessed of an estate consisting of personal property, and that a guardian should be appointed for the estate of said John S. Adsit, insane; and whereas Hiram Adsit was then and there duly appointed as guardian for the estate of said John S. Adsit, insane, and thereafter qualified and entered upon the performance of his duties as such guardian; and whereas thereafter and on the 23rd day of September 1919, and while still the duly appointed, qualified and acting guardian of said John S. Adsit, insane, he the said Hiram Adsit died in Butler County, Kansas, thereby creating a vacancy in the office of guardian of the estate of said John S. Adsit, insane; and whereas said estate has not been fully administered, and said John S. Adsit is still an insane person, and is still possessed of an estate consisting of both real and personal property in Butler County, Kansas, and a guardian should be appointed.

Now to wit on this 29th day of October 1919, comes on to be heard the application for an appointment of a guardian for the estate of John Adsit, Insane.

The court being fully advised in the premises finds that heretofore and that on the 3rd day of May 1900, John Adsit was duly and legally adjudged insane by trial in the Probate Court of Butler County, Kansas, and that Hiram Adsit was duly appointed guardian for the estate of said John Adsit, Insane, and that such Hiram Adsit duly qualified and entered upon the discharge of his duties as guardian for the estate of John Adsit, Insane.

The court further finds that such Hiram Adsit continued to discharge the duties of guardian of said John Adsit, Insane, from the date of his appointment and qualification until the 25th day of September 1919, on which date the said Hiram Adsit died.

The court further finds that a new guardian should be appointed for the estate of John Adsit and that Rachel Smith is a fit and proper person to be appointed guardian of said John Adsit, Insane.

It is therefore by the court considered, ordered and adjudged that said Rachel Smith be and she is hereby appointed guardian for the estate of John Adsit, Insane, and that upon her filing in this court a good and sufficient bond in the sum of Seven Thousand Five Hundred (\$7,500.00) Dollars, conditioned as provided by law that letters of guardianship shall thereupon issue to the said Rachel Smith.

Thereafter and on the 6th day of November 1919, comes Rachel Smith and files in said court her declination and refusal to accept the appointment of guardian for the estate of John Adsit, Insane; which said declination and refusal is accepted by the court; and thereupon the court finds

that C. E. Thompson of El Dorado, Kansas, is a proper person to be appointed guardian of the estate of John Adsit, Insane.

It is therefore by the court considered, ordered, decreed and adjudged that C. E. Thompson of El Dorado, Kansas, be and he is hereby appointed guardian of the estate of John Adsit, Insane; and that upon filing in this court his oath and bond as such guardian as required by law that letters of guardianship shall thereupon issue to the said C. E. Thompson; and thereupon the said C. E.
