and truly pay or cause to be paid unto
the above named Martin Prudgast
his executors administrators & assigns
the just and full sum of four
hundred and fifty dollars with interest
in six years from the date hereof
and shall pay the interest thereon
annually on the fifth day of October
in each & every year without any
fraud or delay then this obligation
to be void otherwise to remain in full
force & virtue
