

The last will & Testament of W<sup>m</sup> Buel:

July 26<sup>th</sup> 1811

The will of W<sup>m</sup> Buel in disposing his estate. I give to my son Samuel the house & have the Horse lot with an Island of partridge of W<sup>m</sup> Hillier & to my son Peter have the Homestead on the North side & all the meadow & wood land that was my own by gift of the Tama; my Tools to be equally divided betwixt Samuel & Peter my son Samuel is to pay out eleven pounds & Peter six pounds & this with the rest of my goods to be equally divided between my daughters only my daughter Mary to have five pounds more than either of the other. These two parcels of land one by the Gravel Hill the other by the Mill brook which I leave to my wife disposing of she or her line, she is to enjoy all this as long as she lives, This I do with the best of my understanding
