NORTHFIELD CEMETERY  
LITCHFIELD, CONNECTICUT  
CORP. Joseph E. Camp, son of Dr. D. B. & F. J. Camp. Killed  
in battle at Cold Harbor, Va. June 1, 1864, age 22. "He  
sleeps in secret, but his grave unknown to man is marked by  
God."

SPERRY CEMETERY  
BETHANY, CONNECTICUT  
In memory of Ichabod UMBERFIELD who was murdered by a maniac  
January 1, 1856, age 71  
"A mournful New Year's day to my surviving friends. How  
sudden I am called away soon as the year begins."

WEST CEMETERY  
LITCHFIELD, CONNECTICUT  
Here lies the body of Mrs. Mary, wife of Dr. John Buell  
Esq. She died November 4, 1768, age 90  
"Having had 13 children, 101 grandchildren, 274 great grand  
children, 22 great great grandchildren, total of 410 of which  
336 survived her."

OLD NORTH CEMETERY  
HARTFORD, CONNECTICUT  
On the Thomas Day lot will be found on a square stone;  
"Those who cared for him while living will know whose  
body lies resting here to others it does not matter."  
September 1892.

SMALL POX CEMETERY  
EAST GRANBY CONNECTICUT  
Holcomb, Deacon Joshua died of smallpox April 16, 1784 in  
the 161st year of his age.  
Cemetery is on top of Mantauk Mountain on the property of  
William Seymour.

GROVE STREET CEMETERY  
PUTNAM, CONNECTICUT  
Phineas G. Wright, died May 2, 1918, going but know not  
where.
