

At a Town Meeting in Shillingworth Dec<sup>r</sup> 18. 1713—  
It was agreed & Voted that the Country Road through the  
quarter shall run Straight Down from the Gate till  
it come past the Lot formerly Nathaniel Haydens &  
So to Run through the Parsonage Lot till it comes to  
the old Road at the westerly Side of the Parsonage Lot  
To Highway to be two Rods wide & to be laid by a Com<sup>tee</sup>  
Chosen by the Town who are Capt. Griswold Engr<sup>n</sup>  
Willior & S<sup>r</sup> Josiah Steevens —

Also the Town granted to Benj. Buell about an acre  
& a half of Land which was formerly viewed by a  
Committee on his account near his orchard he paying  
to the Town at the Rate of 2<sup>d</sup> per acre as money  
& to be Laid out by a Committee who are Capt. Griswold  
John Willior & Peter Ward & not to prejudice any for  
mer grant or Highway —

Also the Town grants to W<sup>m</sup> Barber what Land  
may be found on the westerly Side of his Land at the  
Bend of Marquetteet River he paying to the  
Town twenty Shillings per acre as money & said  
Land to be laid out at the Diserepion of the Com<sup>tee</sup>  
appointed by the Town & not to prejudice any for  
mer grant or Highway the Com<sup>tee</sup> are Serj<sup>t</sup> Welman  
Nath<sup>l</sup> Parmele & John Lane —

It was also agreed & Voted that they would Sell all  
all that Common Land at the great Hammock on  
the westerly & Southerly Side of the Highway & Land  
adjoining to James Steevens his Land & to Sell s<sup>d</sup> Land  
at a Vendue - also in like manner to Sell an acre  
& a quarter of Land formerly laid out & Bounded  
by order of the Town on the Northerly Side of the  
Long Point in the Planting field —

Also S<sup>r</sup> Buell S<sup>r</sup> Sheldy & Peter Ward are Chosen  
a Com<sup>tee</sup> to view a piece of Land Capt. Griswold
