Be it Remembered, That at a Term of the Court of Common Pleas, begun and held at Akron, within and for said County, on the *twenty first* day of *May* A. D. 1844, personally came *William Danappel* an Alien and subject of the King of *Germany* and made application to be naturalized under the Laws of the United States; and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court by sufficient testimony, that the said *William Danappel* had made his declaration of intention to become a Citizen of the United States, according to law, at least two years before this application; that he has been a resident of the United States for at least five years last past, and of this State for at least one year last past; and also that, during that time, he has behaved as a man of good moral character, attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and well disposed to the good order and happiness of the same. == It was therefore ordered by said Court, that the oath of allegiance be administered to the said applicant, and that a certificate of naturalization be issued to him in due form of law. == Whereupon the said *William Danappel* made oath in open Court, that he would support the Constitution of the United States, and that he absolutely and entirely renounced and abjured all allegiance and fidelity to every foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty whatever; and particularly to *Heremich* King of *Germany*

THEREFORE, The said *William Danappel* is hereby declared a Citizen of the United States, and entitled to enjoy all privileges and immunities as such.
