 as follows; Being a part of Lot Number Two in Range Number eight in Township  
 Number two in the Eleventh Range of Townships in the Connecticut Western Reserve  
 and which is also in the State of Ohio Bounded as follows. Beginning at a post standing  
 on the South line of a now County road Leading from Akron to Middleburg said post  
 unto the North East corner of a Lot owned by William Ross, thence S 1¼° E. 4.64 links  
 to a post standing in the South line of the said Miner Spicers farm thence 88° E 250½  
 owned by George Babcock, thence North 1¼° W. 335 links to a post standing in the South  
 line of the road above mentioned, thence North 64° to 281 links to the place of beginning.  
 Containing one acre of land be the same more or less but subject to all legal highways  
 To Have and to Hold the above Granted and Bargained premises, with the appurtenances

 whatever. And I the said Johanna Denapple do hereby Remise Release and forever Quit Claim  
 unto the said Barbara Denapple her heirs and assigns all my right and title of Dower in the
