Beginning Monday, November 20, 1899, the regular working hours of this factory on|every|day except Saturday, will be, until further notice, as follows:

From 6:30 until 11:30 a.m.

From 12:30 until 5:15 p.m.

On Saturday from 6:30 until 11:45 a.m.

Fifty-four (54) hours to constitute a week's work.
