

# SIXTY PER CENT. PAID.

## DISTRIBUTION OF THE TOR- NADO RELIEF FUNDS.

### LIST OF THOSE WHO RECEIVED RELIEF AND THE AMOUNTS ALLOWED BY THE COMMITTEE.

The committee appointed to assess the damages sustained by the citizens who were visited by the tornado that swept through the southern portion of the city are making distributions of the the money raised by the soliciting committee. The amount raised by the soliciting committee was \$8,501 which is only a little more than half enough to pay the amount fixed by the adjusting committee, the members of which say that it is a shame that a city of Akron's size and wealth cannot raise as much to aid sufferers at home as they do to aid outsiders. There was not enough to pay 63 cents on the dollar for which the damage was assessed, so it was made 60 cents on the dollar. Therefore a very small surplus will be left in the treasury for future use. Some of those being helped are complaining because their neighbors received more than they did, while nearly all are thankful for the aid the citizens have given them. The committee found some cases among the sufferers who are unable to earn anything and in such cases have allowed the full amount of damage. For instance, Mrs. Neal, in whose house the Irish family lived, is a widow, aged and unable to earn anything and instead of asking for the money asks the committee to rebuild her house for her, which will undoubtedly be done.
