

bound & Obliged unto Francis Foxcroft Esq. Judge of
the Probate of Wills, or for the said County in the sum
of One hundred pound of current money of said Pro-
vince To be paid to the said Judge his Assignee in this
Office his or their Assignee To whose payment I
and myself my Executors & Assignees firmly
these presents sealed with my seal dated the
12th of the first day of January 1722. of his Majesty King
George over Great Britain

The Condition of this Obligation is that if Whereas the above bounden
Henry Farwell hath this day taken upon himself the Execution
of the Last Will & Testament of the late Joseph Farwell of Dunstable aforesaid
by this day proving the same & thereby taking upon him the Burden of paying his Debt
Calgary &c. Now if accordingly that Henry Farwell my Executors
Assignees or Administrators or any of them or other by his or their
Order shall do & perform & fulfill that which will be due
according to the true intent & meaning of the same without
fraud or deceit Then this above written Obligation shall be
void & of none Effect & else not
