

MRS. H. E. HAYMAN DIES LAST NIGHT

Mrs. Herbey E. Hayman, aged 59 years, who resided on a farm seven miles northwest of Oil Hill, died here last night. Death came as the result of complications which set in following a fall at her home about a month ago in which her leg was broken.

Mrs. Hayman had resided in Butler County all her life and was well known in this community. Born on a farm near Towanda on February 23, 1875, she resided there until her marriage on April 6, 1892. The couple then removed to the farm home northwest of Oil Hill and had lived there since. Mrs. Hayman was a member of the Methodist Church at Towanda and also belonged to the Rebekah Lodge here.

Surviving are her husband; a daughter, Mrs. L. E. McCulloch, of the Towanda Community, and a brother, William Heath, of Eureka.

Funeral services will be held at the Methodist Church, at Towanda, tomorrow afternoon at 2 o'clock with Rev. M. J. Paulin officiating. Interment will be made in the Towanda Cemetery. The Alderson-Arnold Funeral Home is in charge.
