## TOWANDA SUICIDE AT NOON TODAY

Frank Heath, Son of John Heath, Blows His Head Off With a Shotgun

Frank Heath committed suicide at his home one mile east of Towanda today noon, by shooting the whole top of his head off with a shotgun. He was not in his right mind. For some time he has been suffering with spinal trouble and was in the Wichita hospital for about a month. Sunday he was determined to go home and when refused became frantic; so he was brought home. All week his mind has been wandering but he was not violent. He was 30 years of age, is a son of Mr. and Mrs. John Heath of Towanda where he has lived all his live. He leaves a wife and three small children. Coroner Hunt went over this afternoon to hold an inquest.

Coroner Hunt went to Towanda Friday and viewed the remains of Frank Heath but concluded an inquest was unnecessary.

The funeral of the deceased was held in Towanda at eleven o'clock this morning at the home of the family. Interment was made in the Towanda cemetery. The deceased leaves a wife and three children. Mrs. Heath graduated from our city schools in 1895, winning first honors.
