Shot Himself,

Frank Heath a Suicide—Shot Himself in the Head and Died Instantly—Had Been Sick for Several Weeks—Supposed Cause Was Ill Health.

Takes His Own Life.

Frank Heath shot and killed himself today, June 26, at his home one and a half miles east of Towanda, The weapon used was a shot-gun. While the family was at dinner he made the excuse that he was not hungry, went out to a corn crib and the gun's report soon made known the tragedy.

Mr. Heath was about thirty years old and leaves a wife and three children. He has been sick and despondent for many weeks. He was in a Wichita hospital for a few days, being treated for a spinal trouble and was allowed to return home yesterday because the physicians believed he would become a raving maniac if kept there longer.

His illness was the primary cause of his self-destruction but it is believed that financial difficulties also added to the load which he found unbearable.

Frank Heath was an honest, hard working man.
