The last Will and Testament of
Severin Reider of the City of Paterson
in the County of Passaic and State of
New Jersey -

I The said Severin Reider do hereby
make public and declare this my
last will and testament in manner
and form following, to wit -

First - I order and direct all my
just debts and funeral expenses to be
paid by my executor, as soon after
my death as conveniently may be -
Second - I give devise and bequeath
unto my wife Josephine Reider all my
remaining estate both real and personal
in whatever it may consist, or wherever
situated at the time of my decease, to be
by her used and disposed of during her
natural life, precisely the same as I my-
self might do were I living; and hereby
give my said wife full power to sell,
exchange, invest and reinvest the same, in
the same manner I might do if living; and
to distribute the same by gift or otherwise
among my children at any time during
her life as to her shall seem meet and
proper; and to appoint the same among
my said children by will after her

decease in such proportions as she may deem fit -

Third - If any of my said estate shall remain undisposed by ^{my} said wife at the time of her decease by will or otherwise I give devise and bequeath all such residue and remainder of my estate to be equally divided between my children Henry Reider and Josephine Reider, if they shall both be living at that time; otherwise to the survivor of them -

Fourth - If my said wife should survive both of my children, then upon her death I direct that my estate then remaining be divided into two equal portions, one of which shall be equally divided among my legal heirs and representatives, and the other of which shall be equally divided between the legal heirs and representatives of my said wife -

Lastly, I hereby nominate and appoint as sole executrix of this my last-will and testament my said wife Josephine Reider, hereby revoking any and every other will by me at any time heretofore made and declaring this writing and this writing only to constitute my last-will and testament -
