

At a Town meeting at Chatham Capt John Atkins Chosen Moderator ye 11th June 1728 regularly assembled & warned to raise money to build a new meeting house and then & then the vote was to raise Five hundred pounds the one half to be raised this present year that is in the year 1728 & the other half to be raised in ye next year - that is in ye year 1729 to be laid out in building a new meeting house

At a Town meeting ye 24th June 1728 regular warned Capt Harding Moderator

At ye same meeting they choise of Insign Will Nickerson & Will Bedredg to serve in ye office of Jury of trials for this ensuing Court at Barnstable

At ye same town meeting ye inhabitation voted to take the money made by the Province at Boston by ye Province

At the same Town meeting ye inhabitation made choise of Capt Harding & Daniel Sears, Samuel Taylor Justices to fetch our money made by ye Province at Boston

At ye same meeting ye inhabitation voted to build a new meeting house with as much speed as might be with convenience

At ye same meeting it was voted to build our meeting house of the same dimentions of ye South meeting house in Eastham

At ye same town meeting ye town voted to set ye meeting house one or near ye same spot or lot of land

At ye same meeting they made choise of Capt Harding Insign Nickerson & John Rides agents to agree with for ye building and finishing ye said new meeting house

At ye same meeting they made choise of Sert Tho. Nickerson, Nathaniel Cornell & Tho. Atkins agents settle ye bounds between our town & Harwich Recorded by Tho. Atkins Town Clerk
