The undersigned applicant, state & that one Wm. A. Rider died intestate in Nodaway Township, in Adams County, State of Iowa on the 2nd day of February, 1923; that the body of said deceased was buried on the 6th day of February, 1923; that at the time of his death deceased was a resident of Adams County, Iowa; that said deceased left a spouse surviving, to-wit: one Helen J. BOND OF F. W. Rider, Administrator

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, F. W. Rider and P. F. Cushman, as principal, and all of the County of Adams, and State of Iowa, are held and firmly bound unto the County of Adams, State of Iowa, for the use and benefit of all persons interested in said estate of Wm. A. Rider in the sum of two thousand \$ DOLLARS, lawful money of the United States, for the payment of which sum we jointly and severally bind ourselves, our executors and administrators, heirs, devisees and legal representatives firmly by these presents.

THE CONDITIONS of the foregoing obligations are, that, whereas the above named principal has been duly appointed administrator of the estate of Wm. A. Rider deceased;

If said principal will as such administrator render a true account of his office and of his doings therein to the proper authority, when required thereby or by law; and will promptly pay over to the person or officer entitled thereto, all money which may come into his hands by virtue of his said office; and will promptly account for all balances of money remaining in his hands at the termination of his office; and will exercise all reasonable diligence and care in the preservation and lawful disposal of all money, books, papers and securities, or other property appertaining to his said office and deliver them to his successor or to any person authorized to receive the same; and will faithfully and impartially, without fear, favor, fraud or oppression, discharge all of the duties now or hereafter required of his office by law, the surety on this bond to be liable for all money or property that may come into the hands of said principal at anytime during his possession of said office; then this bond to be void, otherwise in full force.
