

This is a picture of the Glencoe Presbyterian Church believed to be the oldest Presbyterian Church, in its original form, still in use, in North Dakota today, October 1968. The picture was taken during the year 1885.

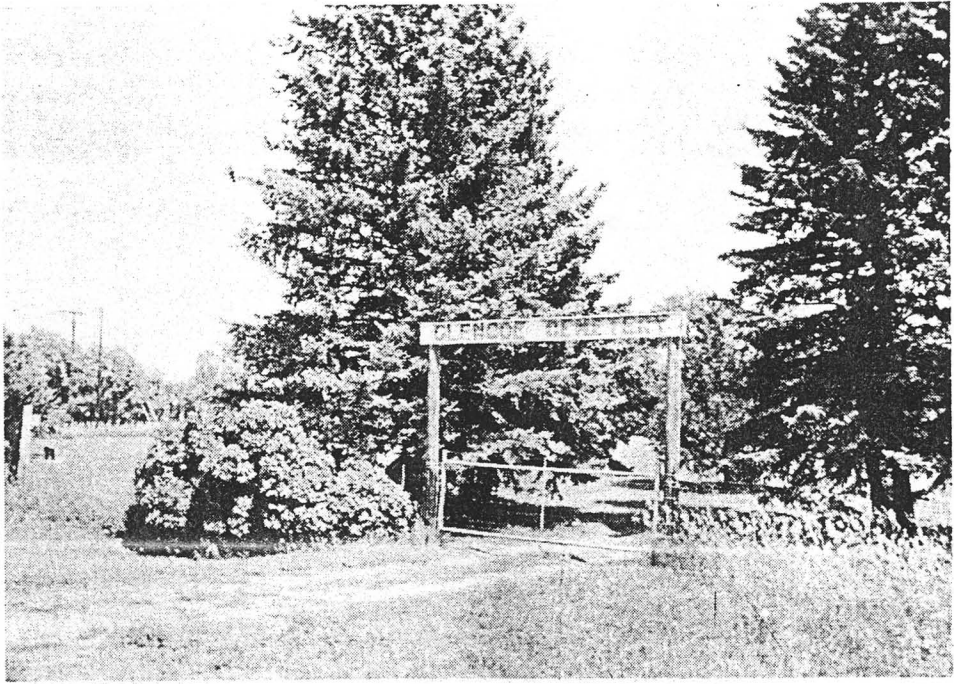
Reverend Issac O. Sloan stands in the foreground. The Church is located in the South one-half of the Southeast quarter of Section 32, Township 137, Range 78, Burleigh County. It was first named Albert Barnes Memorial Presbyterian Church in honor of Reverend Barnes of Philadelphia who inspired Reverend Sloan to be a Missionary Minister. Reverend Sloan continued to be its pastor for many years. The name was changed to Sloan Memorial Presbyterian Church of Glencoe during the year 1923 and remains its official name as this record is being made, October 1968. However, the Church is generally referred to as the "Glencoe Church".

When the Church was built it was believed it was being located in Emmons County but when the county lines were established it was discovered the Church was located immediately across the county line in Burleigh County; kitty-corner from the Cemetery which is located in Emmons County.

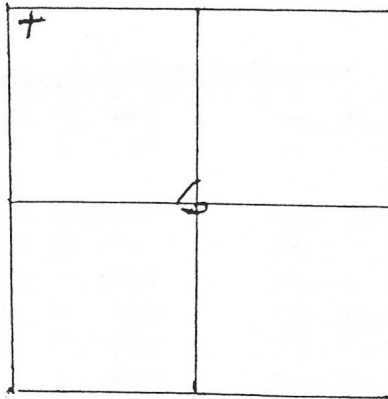
There remains some question with respect to when construction of the Church actually started or when it was actually completed. There can be no question but what a Presbyterian Church group existed in the settlement several years before construction of the Church actually started.

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As of March 30, 1992 The church is still being used. They are having services every Sunday. The only changes being the door has been replaced and the front steps.
