March 2 Samuel Glade of the town of Littlefield in the County of Thurston executor of Anthony Glade late of Colorado in the County of Thurston deceased presented his petition duly verified setting forth the matter and things required to be done in such petition and praying that the paper presented by him might be admitted to probate as a will of personal property and received as a will of real property. On filing said petition ordered that citations issue for the proof of the will and a copy to be published in the State paper six weeks - citations issued returnable on the 15th day of April

April 18 The petition appeared and made the proof of the same and publication of the notice as required by law, and filing the same before that proof of the execution of the will to the Honorable Circuit and District the subscribing witnesses to the will appeared and their objections were taken and taken from such testimony taken under oath etc. appeared that the will was executed and attested in the manner pointed by law and that the testator at the time of executing the same was in all respects competent to make a will, choosing real estate and was under no restraint.  Joseph H. Eysanum in the special sum of \$50. to the
 said Alonzo Eysanum in the special sum of fifty-five
