THAT WE *Asa Whittmore yeoman of Leicester Benben Whittmore
Jeremiah Whittmore yeoman + Eben Kingsbury cabinet maker of Spencer*
all in the County of Worcester, within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, are holden and stand firmly bound and obliged unto

Nathaniel Paine, Esquire, Judge of the Probate of Wills, and for granting Administrations, within the County of Worcester, in the full sum of *Ten Thousand* Dollars, to be paid unto the said

Nathaniel Paine, his Successors in the said Office, or Assigns:—To the true Payment whereof, we do bind ourselves and each of us, our, and each of our Heirs Executors and Administrators jointly and severally, for the whole and in the whole, firmly by these Presents. Sealed with our Seals. Dated the *twenty first* Day of *May* in the Year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and *three*.
