1st
It is my will that all my just debts
and funeral expenses be first paid
out of my estate as soon as found convenient

2nd
I give devise and bequeath to my
daughter Lillie Beckenbach my lot
of land located on Delaware street and
known as sub lot No 52 in Perry and
Payne's allotment of original 10 acre lot
No 112 and being the same premises
deeded to me by deed dated Sept. 13. 1870 and
recorded in Vol 179 Page 104 of deeds
of Cuyahoga County records to have and
to hold to her own use and benefit forever
in fee simple

3
I give devise and bequeath to my
daughter Olga Wrisler my lot of land
located on Hadley street and known
as sub lot No 9 in Bowers' allotment
of part of original lots Nos 125 & 126 and
being the same premises deeded to me
by deed dated Sept 3. 1887 and recorded
in Vol 419. Page 12 of Cuyahoga County

Records to have and to hold to her
own use and benefit for ever in
fee simple I also give and bequeath
to my said daughter Olga my sewing
machine

4th
I give and bequeath to my son
Emil Winger the sum of
Fourteen Hundred and sixty seven
Dollars; this is addition to what
he receives from my insurance policy
making in all Eighteen Hundred Dollars
However this amount bequeathed by
this will to wit the \$1467⁰⁰ is to be
retained by my Executor hereinafter
^{named} and to be paid by my Executor to my
said son in monthly payments of
Fifteen Dollars each. without interest
until the full amount is paid this
bequest under no circumstance to be
liable to execution or sale nor has my
said son any authority or right to sell
or dispose of the same in any manner
whatsoever and in the event of the my
said son disposing of said bequest
or attempting to do so this bequest
shall go to and be the property of
my two daughters Lillie & Olga
My Executor hereinafter mentioned is hereby
empowered should he deem it wise or
to the best interest of my said son at
any time to give him a greater sum
than the \$15⁰⁰ per month or the whole

amount remaining unpaid he may
do so and his action in this regard
shall be a full satisfaction of the am-
ount so paid by him and he given
full credit as Executor for the amount so paid

5th I give and bequeath to my Granddaughter
Ruby L. Beckenbach One Hundred Dollars
to be paid to her in Cash —

6th I give devise and bequeath to my two
daughters Lillie Beckenbach and Olga
Kinger all the rest and residue of
my property that I may own or hold
at the time of my decease both personal
al- Real or mixed of every kind and nature
whatsoever to have and to hold to their own
use and benefit for ever in fee simple
share and share alike

7th I do hereby nominate and appoint my
son-in-law Albert Beckenbach Executor
of this my last will and testament I
desire that no appraisement or sale
of my personal property be made and
that no bond be required of my said Executor
and hereby request the Court of Probate
to direct the admission of the same
in pursuance to the Statute in such
Case made and provided
