

Article from the Globe – Atchison, Kansas July 23, 1881

Two white boys, James Carroll, aged 11, Thomas Carroll, aged 13, and a colored boy named William Johnson, aged 11, claiming to have come from Denver a week ago, where their parents reside, were up before the police court to-day charged with passing counterfeit money. After reading them a sound lecture, and advising them to make tracks for Denver, the Marshal gave them an hour in which to leave the city, on pain of the rock pile behind the calaboose.
