

Denaple, N. H. Kiwanian, Hurt In Fall

Richard Denaple, 57-year-old president of the North Hollywood Federal Savings & Loan Co., was in St. Joseph hospital, Burbank, today, suffering from a broken vertebrae sustained in a fall en-route to the Kiwanis division conference at Palmdale Monday.

Dr. Burt Church, president of North Hollywood Kiwanis, who was on the special chartered train,

called an ambulance which brought Denaple to the hospital. It was understood that he will be a patient from four to six weeks and will be required to wear a cast for some time after he is discharged.

Denaple, who is vice-president of the chamber of commerce, fell as the train neared Palmdale. About 350 Kiwanians from the third and sixteenth districts, comprising San Fernando Valley and part of Hollywood, were on the train. Dr. Church telegraphed ahead for an ambulance.

Although in extreme pain, Denaple urged his associates to proceed with their plans for a festive barbecue as guests of the Palmdale and Lancaster clubs.

Denaple resides with his family at 10944 Landale st., North Hollywood.
