Y<sup>e</sup> 14<sup>th</sup> of November I baptized 3 children, viz Abraham Geals child (who is a member y<sup>e</sup> church) viz Ebenezer, it was young. & Abigall Townfends child (her husbands name I know not) viz Martin. & John Bonds child, called Abigall, not a fortnight old

Y<sup>e</sup> 21. of November 86 I baptized 12, viz Tredaways child called Jofiah, & John Chinerys child (who owned y<sup>e</sup> Cov<sup>t</sup>) called Sarah, & 5 of old Simon Millings children, viz Simon, Richard, Mary, James, & John. & David Fifks wife viz Elizabeth (in order to Admifion) & her child David. & George Adams wife Martha who owned y<sup>e</sup> Cov<sup>t</sup>, & her child called George. & Mary Adams

Y<sup>e</sup> 28 of Nov. 86 I baptized 9 viz 4 children of Tho. Underwood (who owned y<sup>e</sup> Cov<sup>t</sup> privately, & his wife publickly) viz Thomas, Jonathan, Mary & Elizabeth. And Jonathan Smithes wife viz Jane. And Sarah Jane and her child Jonathan, & Widow Fitks daughter viz Elizabeth. And Sarah Sanders, viz William Sanders daughter. And Samuell Severn y<sup>e</sup> widows son

Y<sup>e</sup> 5 of December 86. I baptized 7, viz 6 of John Aplin who owned y<sup>e</sup> Cov<sup>t</sup>, viz John, Thomas, Mary, Hannah, Bafuah, Abiah. & Benjamin Davis who owned y<sup>e</sup> Cov<sup>t</sup>

Such as were Admitted by me to Full Communion In Watertown—1687

Y<sup>e</sup> 31 of July 1687 I admitted 6, viz Tho. Cutler, Thomas Millings, Benjamin Goddard, Sarah Cuttings, Abiah Leason, & Elizabeth Willington, I spent some time in a word in Benj. Goddards relation, viz a child of y<sup>e</sup> Covn<sup>t</sup>, oh y<sup>t</sup> g<sup>d</sup> wid blefse it for much good. Eliz. Willington is y<sup>e</sup> wife of Joseph Willington

Y<sup>e</sup> 13<sup>th</sup> of November I admitted 7, viz Philip Shattock, Benjamin Flegg, Jonathan Stimfon, Abigall Townfend (y<sup>e</sup> wife of Martin Townfend) Elizabeth Chinery (y<sup>e</sup> wife of John Chinery) Sufanna Grout (y<sup>e</sup> wife of Joseph Grout) Elizabeth Nevenfon (y<sup>e</sup> wif of John Nevinfon, whom I admitted w<sup>thout</sup> a Relation her husband who is of y<sup>e</sup> church of England wid not suffer it, but y<sup>e</sup> church was fatiffyed in her w<sup>thout</sup> it), I hope g<sup>d</sup> will blefse y<sup>m</sup>, & make y<sup>m</sup> blefsings

Y<sup>e</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> of January I admitted 3, viz M<sup>r</sup> William Goddard, Abigail Fox (y<sup>e</sup> wife of Isaac Fox, of Miftick, or Medford as it is called) & Bithia Satle

Y<sup>e</sup> 4<sup>th</sup> March 1687/8 I admitted 3 viz Calib Church, Stephen Cook, & Abraham Brown I had said something largely to y<sup>m</sup> but y<sup>t</sup> I had other matters y<sup>t</sup> day

Ye 15<sup>th</sup> of Aprill 1688 I admitted one viz Samuell Bigelow.

Y<sup>e</sup> 19 of August 1688 I admitted 6, viz young John Warren & his wife Elizabeth, Benjamin young Richard Child, Martha Fikf, Thomas Thornton.
