

Charles Beauprean, Revolutionary Soldier Entisted Feb'y 14
1777 Served 3 years - Discharged Feb'y 14, 1780
Served as a Sergeant in Capt. Trudwell's Co. 3rd Artillery
Continental Troops, Commanded by Col. John Crane
Pension Papers of Anna Kimberly Beauprean (his wife)
are dated March 4th 1831 at which time Payment began.

There is a story contained in a letter in the family
which says, this same Charles Beauprean, was
one of the party, disguised as Indians who
constituted the famous and historic "Boston
Tea Party"

Died in West Indies 1799, Married at Roxbury Conn.
May 13, 1779, to Anna Kimberly, who was born there in 1759
Their children were Michael M., Mary Ann, and Nancy.
Michael M. was born Sept 5, 1780, Died Apr. 14, 1877 Mayville N.Y.
his Mother Anna Kimberly is buried in Mayville Cemetery -

Mary Ann Beauprean Married Samuel Peck who ~~was~~ ^{was} Parents
of John G. Peck of Grand Rapids Mich. (Mary Ann Beauprean Peck
died in New York City July 12, 1842, Before her Marriage ^{in New York City} he was a Miller
Nancy died when quite young.

Charles Beaujean married Mary or Mary Harris
Aug. 21 - or 1" 1854 in Boston Mass. he died in
West Indies in 1799.
