Charles Beaujean - who was a native of France, Married Mary or Mary James Aug 1st or 2nd 1754 at Boston Mass.

Charles Peter, their son, born in Boston Mass. 1755. Served during whole period of Rev. War part of time as Serj't under Capt. Wm. Treadwell. Col. John Crane's Regiment Continental Artillery according to family letters he was one of the Boston Tea Party. Married Anna Kimberly at Woodbury Conn May 13th 1799. We have a photostatic copy of love letter written by him to Anna Kimberly. This letter came to us from a Mrs. Williams of Newer Col. Anna Kimberly was born at Roxbury Conn. 1759. She died at Mayville, N.Y. and is buried in Cemetery there, Chas. P. died in West Indies in 1799. having gone there in the interest of a family estate. Widow's Pension of \$120⁰⁰ per annum dated 1837. gives her residence at time of application as Windham Green Co. N.Y. age, at that time 78 yrs. Children of Chas. Peter and Anna Kimberly were:

Michael Moses. was born Sept. 5th 1780 died Apr. 14th 1877. at Mayville N.Y. was born at Roxbury Conn. Married Anshy Peck. of Durham, Green Co. N.Y. Sept. 5th 1805.

Mary Ann b. 1782. d. July 12th 1841. married
Remuel Read. Oct. 12th 1805. at Poughkeepsie Ny. her
home at that time being Freshkill Ny.

Nancy Alma b. 1785; died Dec. 1st 1872, married name
Huff. buried at Kent Cliffs Putnam Co. Ny. in
1824-6. she had a dry-goods store at Delancy &
Lewis Streets New York City. 1826-7 no record -
after 1835 she kept a boarding house at same
location. in 1834-5 she was at 155 Madison and
in 1835-6 - was back at 47 Lewis which is the
corner. a fine residential district. In 1838-9.
there was a Beaujean or Beaujeau gymnasium
at 205 Green Street.

Charles Patin b. July 6" 1806, at Durham Green Co. N.Y., died June 24" 1878, at Mayville N.Y. Married Jemah Cook of Windham Feb. 25" 1835. She died Mch. 3" 1877. Children: George Read: Henry Cook. Herman Beers.

George Read — named for Uncle John Read of Grand Rapids, Mich. was b. Feb. 16" 1836, in Windham; died in Buffalo, N.Y. Apr. 6" 1916. Married Martha Kenyon Kelley at Mayville, N.Y. Sept. 2" 1857. who died in 1903. Children:

Henry Cook Bearjean. b. Oct. 25" 1846 — died at Mayville — ^{not married}

Mary Anna Bearjean b. 1782 died July 12" 1841
Married Remuel Read Oct. 12" 1805 at Poughkeepsie N.Y.,
her home was in Fishkill N.Y.

Nancy Alma, born about 1785. died Dec. 1" 1872
married possibly twice — Widow many years
name was Huff: lived for a time at Dr. Jos. H.

Bailey's home at Kent Cliffs, Putnam Co. N.Y. was buried in private Cemetery there. In 1824-26 Nancy Beaujean had a dry-goods store at Delaney + Lewis Streets - N.Y. City. From 1826-29 - no account of her. but after 1835 - she kept a boarding house - same location. In 1834-5 she was at 155 Madison and in 1835-6 - was back at Lewis St. which is also the Corner. In 1838-9 there was a Beaujean or Beaujean Gymnasium at 205 Green St. In an old family letter it mentions that in 1752 a grant of land was made to M. de Beaujean. 1753. to a clarification of grant it appears to be a Dutchess Co. N.Y. or vicinity - Record.

Mary Anna Beaujean daughter of Chas. P. and Anna Kimberly - and sister of Michael Moses. married Lemuel Read. who was the son of William Read and Sarah Hawley of Redding Conn.
